


Who are we?

Bolshee CIC is a female-led non-profit community interest company delivering creative projects for social change in York.

Bolshee Young Creatives is a brand new initiative to give young people aged 8-14 a fun and creative space to be heard! We are calling for all young musicians, performers, dancers, drawers, DJs, technicians, writers, talkers and explorers. No experience necessary just curiosity and imagination!

We want to celebrate all forms of creativity and ALL young people!

We know that coming together to be creative has huge benefits for young people, especially post-COVID covid due to a huge spike in anxiety, social isolation and loneliness amongst our children. We want to change that by creating a weekly, vibrant, friendly and fun space for young people to come together, have their voices heard, feel good, make friends and make things happen in York!









Free places

We would like every young person to have access to Bolshee Young Creatives regardless of their circumstances. That is why we offer free places to:

- Young carers
- Care experienced young people and looked after children
- Young people who are refugees and asylum seekers
- Young people from marginalised communities (i.e Gypsy and Traveller communities)
- Young people facing significant financial hardship

Community Asset

We are proud to be operating this exciting new project out of South Bank Social Club, a beloved but underused social club in the heart of South Bank.

By delivering our sessions here we can contribute to the preservation of an important community asset and protect the heritage of the South Bank area.



How can you help?

All offers of support are gratefully received and go directly into the cost of running Bolshee Young Creatives and providing a wonderful space that EVERY young person can come and be part of.

It costs £85 a term per young person to be a member of Bolshee Young Creatives. This fee covers:

- 3 x experienced DBS-checked professional artists who deliver and run the project.
- Safeguarding and first aid training
- Administration costs
- Marketing and printing costs
- Venue hire
- Resources
- Public liability insurance
- Props, costumes, performance budgets
- Filming and photography
- Transport where there is a barrier

Below are some suggestions of how your support can help.

You can support one disadvantaged young person for one term for £85, or for one year for £255.

You can support two disadvantaged young people for one year for £500.

£3000 would support us to open a new group for 14-16 year olds.
